OUR HISTORY

Jamesport Center was a late Victorian six-story complex. In 1890 it was occupied by the Red Andrews Saloon and Central House Hotel. In 1892 a second structure was added (which is now the entrance to Sunset Bay Antiques). It served as the lobby of the Central House Hotel and provided a dining room, upstairs parlor rooms and additional bedrooms.

In 1905, the final four storefronts were added to provide apartments for the employees of the recently completed Star Watch Case Company on nearby Rath Street. The ground level storefronts of the buildings have been used for a wide variety of trades over the past 120 plus years...including a butcher shop, a hardware store, a clothing shop, various furniture stores and more. Currently, the building is now home to Sunset Bay Antiques and Jamesport Brewing Company.
